



Changes to collection of data for Bikeability cycle training

Update for Head Teacher, Parents, Carers
and Group Leaders who book Bikeability



Cycle training providers must provide anonymised data on the rider characteristics of children taking part in Bikeability



These rider characteristics are; gender, ethnicity, SEND and Pupil Premium eligibility.



The Bikeability Trust and Department for Transport will use this data to tackle issues of equality, diversity and inclusivity. We want all children to be able to access Bikeability.



Your training provider can advise you how they will collect this data. This data will be fully anonymised at the point of reporting to the Trust.
